7th Grade Field Trip to Gettysburg

Hoagie sale – Fairground Market:

- 9" hoagies at \$5.50 each. Hoagies include bologna, cooked ham, American cheese, hard salami, lettuce, tomato, and a packet of dressing. They are made by Fairground Market 1138 New Castle Rd, Prospect, PA 16052
- Start selling now. Collect payment from the customers when you take the orders. Have them make checks payable to you.
- Go to www.logantoursinc.com and place your order. Pay with echeck or credit card.
- Orders can be placed January 1 - January 30.
- Students earn \$2.75 for every hoagie sold.

A sample sale: Hoagies sold: 60 Total \$\$ collected: $60 \times \$5.50 = \330.00 .

Go on logantoursinc.com and pay \$ 330.00

Receive credit for trip of \$2.75 per hoagie, or $2.75 \times 60 = \$165.00$

NOTE: To pay for the trip in full, you need to sell 102 hoagies.

If your sale and payments result in you earning more than you owe, a refund check for your overpayment, no more than \$30, will be mailed to your home from Logan Tours, Incnd.

Candy bar sale – Daffin’s Chocolates:

- Orders due Feb 1
- Pick up candy after school in cafeteria A on Thursday Feb 7
- Sell candy bars for \$1 and earn \$0.50 per bar towards the trip
- Order and pay for as many boxes as you wish to sell at www.logantoursinc.com

Gift donations (refundable if student does not attend) can be made on logantoursinc.com by selecting “payment/donation”. Great Christmas gift idea!

Profit from fundraising will be applied to the student's account up to the amount of the trip, plus \$30 for spending money. Any money raised over that amount will be donated to a tour scholarship fund.

If a student drops out of the tour, any money raised through fundraising will be put in the tour scholarship fund. There are no refunds for any money raised through fund-raising activities.
