

Fund-Raising Information

Product:

- **9” hoagies** at \$5.50 each.
- Hoagies include bologna, cooked ham, American cheese, hard salami, lettuce, tomato, and a packet of dressing.
- Made by Fairground Market in Prospect, PA.

Dates:

- Students may take orders between now and **Tues, March 5**.
- Collect payment (cash or check made to “Logan Tours, Inc”) from the customers **when you take the orders**. Have them make checks payable to **YOU**.
- Then send in ONE check (or cash) payable to “LoganTours, Inc.” for the total amount you owe. Write the student’s first and last name in the memo line.
- **Tues, March 5** - Turn in the "Total Worksheet" and **payment in full** for the hoagies in the morning to the Logan Tours Inc. representative in the cafeteria. A receipt for cash payment will be provided.
- **NEW! Orders and payments can be made online at www.logantoursinc.com**
- Orders will be delivered to the school on **Tuesday, March 19 after school**.
Student Pick up at 2 pm
Parent Pick up from 2:30-4:30 pm

Notes about the Fund-Raiser:

- Students earn \$2.75 for every hoagie sold.
- Profit from the trip will be applied to the student's account up to the amount of the trip, plus \$30 for spending money. Any money raised over that amount will be donated to a tour scholarship fund.
- If a student drops out of the tour, any money raised through fundraising will be put in the tour scholarship fund. There are no refunds for any money raised through fund-raising activities.

A sample sale: Hoagies sold: 60 Total \$\$ collected $60 \times \$5.50 = \$ 330.00$

Turn in money collected in amount of \$ 330.00 – either cash or ONE check to “PA TOURS”

Receive credit for trip of \$2.75 per hoagie, or $2.75 \times 60 = \$ 165.00$

NOTE: *To pay for the trip in full, you need to sell 101 hoagies.*

If your sale and payments result in you earning more than you owe, a refund check for your overpayment, no more than \$30, will be mailed to your home from PA Tours. Any profit in excess of \$30 will go to the tour scholarship fund to help other students be able to attend.
