

Butler 9th Grade Field Trip to NYC

Fundraiser information- Hoagies or Daffin's Candy Bars

Hoagie Sale Info:

- 9" hoagies at \$5.50 each. Hoagies include bologna, cooked ham, American cheese, hard salami, lettuce, tomato, and a packet of dressing. They are made by Fairground Market 1138 New Castle Rd, Prospect, PA 16052.
- Start selling now. Collect payment from the customers when you take the orders. Have them make checks payable to you.
- Go to Logantoursinc.com and place your order. Pay with echeck or credit card (3% fee). Orders are due by November 20.
- Pick up hoagies from IHS Cafeteria B on December 10 after school 3-4 pm.
- Students earn \$2.75 for every hoagie sold.
- Profit from the trip will be applied to the student's account up to the amount of the trip, plus \$30 for spending money. Any money raised over that amount will be donated to a tour scholarship fund.
- If a student drops out of the tour, any money raised through fundraising will be put in the tour scholarship fund. There are no refunds for any money raised through fund-raising activities.

A sample sale: Hoagies sold: 60 Total \$\$ collected: $60 \times \$5.50 = \$ 330.00$.

Go on logantoursinc.com and pay \$ 330.00

Receive credit for trip of \$2.75 per hoagie, or $2.75 \times 60 = \$ 165.00$

NOTE: To pay for the trip in full (assuming Quad occupancy and tickets to Wicked), you need to sell 251 hoagies.

If your sale and payments result in you earning more than you owe, a refund check for your overpayment, no more than \$30, will be mailed to your home from Logan Tours, Inc.

Daffin's Candy sale info:

- Bars sell for \$1 - half goes towards your NYC trip - the other half pays for the candy
- Each box contains 36 bars - variety of milk chocolate, carmel, pretzel pieces, crispy rice,+ peanut butter
- Order and pay \$36 per box at Logantoursinc.com
- Students can pick up their candy during activity period 7 from Mr. Casher in the guidance office
- Parents, please do not come to the school to get your student's candy. **Candy is only available for the students to pick up during activity period in the guidance office.** If they have a large order, they can take home a few boxes each day until they get it all
- If you want order boxes of all the same kind instead of the variety boxes, you will have to pick them up at Daffin's in Sharon. You can make arrangements to do so through Rebecca Green at 724 355 4997.
- Fundraiser runs from now until February (or when supplies run out)
