

Hoagie sale – Fairground Market:

- 9" hoagies at \$5.50 each. Hoagies include bologna, cooked ham, American cheese, hard salami, lettuce, tomato, and a packet of dressing. They are made by Fairground Market.
- Start selling now. Collect payment from the customers when you take the orders. Have them make checks payable to you.
- Go to www.logantoursinc.com and place your order. Pay with echeck or credit card.
- Please place one order per student if possible (combine all orders).
- Sell hoagies now, and submit your order on or before Feb 3.
- Students earn \$2.50 for every hoagie sold.

A sample sale: Hoagies sold: 60 Total collected: $60 \times \$5.50 = \330.00 .

Go on logantoursinc.com, place your order, and pay \$330.00

Receive credit for trip of \$2.50 per hoagie, or $2.50 \times 60 = \$150$

NOTE: To pay for the trip in full, you need to sell 116 hoagies.

If your sale and payments result in you earning more than you owe, you will receive a refund check from Logan Tours, Inc. to put towards spending money for the trip.

Candy bar sale – Daffin's Chocolates

- You can purchase boxes of 36 Daffin's candy bars, mixed variety, for \$36
- Sell the candy for \$1 a bar to get your money back
- You receive 50% profit (\$18 per box) credit in your trip account when you pay for the candy.
- **The boxes can be picked up at the school in front of the principal's office on the following Fridays between 3-3:30 pm: 1/24, 1/31, 2/7, 2/14.**
- The students are *not* permitted to take it home on the bus.
- If you are not able to pick up on Fridays from 3-3:30, contact Rebecca Green to make other arrangements.
- **The candy is not to be brought to school. It should be sold elsewhere!!!**
- Choose to pay by sending a check or cash to Mr. Casher during activity period on Monday, Wednesday, or Friday. Or pay online and pay with a credit card or echeck. You can show up on pickup day with payment, but orders that have been pre-paid will be filled first.

Profit from fundraising will be applied to the student's account up to the amount of the trip, plus \$30 for spending money. Any money raised over that amount will be donated to a tour scholarship fund.

If a student drops out of the tour, any money raised through fundraising will be put in the tour scholarship fund. There are no refunds for any money raised through fund-raising activities.
